16	contributes to the rich cultural heritage and economic well-
17	being of the state and its communities by promoting tourism and
18	contributing to increased property values; and

22	conditions in their communities; and
23	WHEREAS, an exemption or partial exemption from the
24	property tax for historic properties would encourage owners of
25	those properties to maintain the character and historic
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1 integrity of the properties;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE 2 3 OF NEW MEXICO that the taxation and revenue department be requested to conduct a study of the feasibility of and the 4 state costs associated with an exemption or partial property 5 tax exemption for the taxable value of historic properties 6 located in the state, including properties listed on the state 7 register of cultural properties and other properties located 8 within designated historic districts; and 9 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the taxation and revenue department be requested to submit a written report of the 11 12 findings of its study to the New Mexico senate; and 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of the report be filed in duplicate with the legislative council service library; and 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be 15 transmitted to the secretary of taxation and revenue. 16 - 2 -17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24

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
