AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTIONS; PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL TESTING OF VOTING SYSTEMS AT THE REQUEST OF A COUNTY OR STATE PARTY CHAIRPERSON.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new section of the Election Code is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] VOTING SYSTEMS--ADDITIONAL TESTING. --

A. A county or state political party chairperson may request, and the county clerk shall allow, that an independent technician be allowed to test the voting systems to be used in an election prior to their certification. The requested testing may be done up to three days before the county clerk tests and certifies the voting system for use in the election.

B. A county or state political party chairperson
may request, and the county clerk shall allow, that an
independent technician be allowed to test a voting system that
was used in an election if there is an undercount of two
percent or more on that voting system. Testing shall be done
in accordance with secretary of state rules that ensure the
safety and security of the voted ballots on that voting system.

C. As used in this section:

- (1) "undervote" means the percentage of voters in an election that voted in that election but that did not cast a vote for:
- (a) any candidate for governor on the ballot; or
- (b) any candidate for any one federal office on the ballot: and
- (2) "voting system" means any type of mechanical or electronic vote recording or tabulating system."

Section 2. Section 1-11-6 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1969, Chapter 240, Section 216, as amended) is amended to read:

"1-11-6. VOTING MACHINES--MANNER OF PREPARING.--Thirty days prior to an election the county clerk shall:

A. certify to the secretary of state and all <u>state</u> and county party [chairmen] chairpersons the type and serial number of each voting machine intended to be used in each precinct, by precinct number; and

1	B. prepare, in the presence of those persons
2	entitled to be present, the lever voting machines and
3	electronic voting machines for the election as follows:
4	(1) all public, candidate and question
5	counters shall be set at zero;
6	(2) assisted by watchers, each [such] counter
7	shall be tested for accuracy by casting votes upon it until it
8	correctly registers each vote cast;
9	(3) each [such] counter shall be reset at zero
10	and the voting machine shall be immediately sealed with a
11	numbered metal seal so as to prevent operation of the machine
12	or its registering counters without breaking the seal; and
13	(4) on the certificate for that voting machine
14	there shall be recorded:
15	(a) the number on the seal; and
16	(b) the reading shown on the protective
17	counter."
