second, fifth, sixth, seventh, eleventh and thirteenth judicial districts, expand mediation services to additional judicial districts and fund network services for training and quality assurance:

(3) one hundred twenty-eight thousand two hundred forty-eight dollars (\$128, 248) to expand existing 7 court-appointed special advocate programs in the fourth, fifth, 8 sixth, seventh, eleventh, twelfth and thirteenth judicial 9 districts and add new programs in the sixth and thirteenth judicial districts;

(4) two hundred forty thousand nine hundred fifty-eight dollars (\$240,958) to maintain existing access and visitation programs in the first, second, fifth, ninth and thirteenth judicial districts, add new programs to additional judicial districts and fund network services for training and quality assurance.

Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining B. at the end of fiscal year 2006 shall revert to the general fund.
