- 1. On page 1, line 12, before the period, insert "EXTENDING ELIGIBILITY TO DEPENDENTS OF CERTAIN NEW MEXICO RESIDENTS REGARDLESS OF PLACE OF GRADUATION; EXTENDING ELIGIBILITY TO TRIBAL COLLEGES".
- 2. On page 1, line 24, after "school", insert "and the governing boards of regionally accredited tribal colleges located in New Mexico".
- 3. On page 3, between lines 16 and 17, insert the following new subsection:
- "E. The tuition scholarships authorized in this section shall also apply to full-time resident students who are accepted for entrance to and attend one of the public post-secondary educational institutions set forth in this section if they:
 - (1) are the dependents of New Mexico residents who:
 - (a) work for state, federal or tribal government;
 - (b) are temporarily assigned outside the state;
 - (c) file New Mexico income tax returns; and
- (2) were required to complete high school out of state because of their parents' work assignment.".
