1 department. Persons completing a course and passing an 2 examination on a particular grade of property valuation and property tax administration shall be issued an appraiser's 3 4 certificate of an appropriate grade. [No] A person shall not 5 be issued an appraiser's certificate of a particular grade unless [he] the person has been issued an appraiser's 6 7 certificate for each one of the lesser grades. The appraiser's 8 certificates shall be denominated "Appraiser 1", "Appraiser 2", 9 "Appraiser 3" and "Appraiser 4" and shall be granted in order 10 of difficulty of the course and examination completed. The "Appraiser 4" certificate shall be granted for completion of 11 12 the most difficult course. County assessors or appraisers who 13 have been granted an "Appraiser 4" certificate shall be 14 designated "New Mexico certified appraiser" and shall be 15 provided by the taxation and revenue department with a 16 certificate granting this designation."

Section 2. Section 4-39-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1969, Chapter 269, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:

QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPRAISER'S CERTIFICATES. -- The taxation and revenue department, in cooperation and in keeping with the standards of the international association of assessing officers or the real estate appraisers board, shall establish the qualifications that are prerequisite to the issuance of each grade of appraiser's certificate."
