16	Section 1. Section 10-11A-6 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1983,

19	A. A member may claim one year of service credit
20	for each year in which a fire department certifies that the
21	member:
22	(1) attended seventy-five percent of all
23	scheduled fire drills;
24	(2) attended seventy-five percent of all
25	scheduled business meetings; and

1 (3) participated in at least fifty percent of all emergency response calls for which the fire department held 2 3 [him] the member responsible to attend. B. The chief of each fire department shall submit 4 to the association by March 31 of each year the records of 5 attendance of members for emergency response calls, fire drills 6 7 and business meetings during the preceding calendar year; provided, [he] that the chief shall: 8 submit such records on forms provided by 9 (1)10 the association: (2)acknowledge the truth of the records under 11 12 oath before a notary public; and have the notarized forms signed by the 13 (3) mayor, if distributions from the fire protection fund for the 14 fire department are made to an incorporated municipality, or 15 the chairman of the county commission, if distributions from 16 the fire protection fund for the fire department are made to an 17 independent fire district. 18 C. For service credit that has been earned, but not 19 20 credited pursuant to Subsection B of this section, a member may post or adjust service credit earned for one or more calendar 21 years prior to January 1, 2005, but for not more than five 22 years of additional service credit, by filing with the 23 association no later than December 31, 2005: 24 (1) a copy of the state fire marshal's records 25
