15	Section 1. APPROPRIATION
16	A. One million five hundred nineteen thousand nine

18	fund to the human services department for expenditure in fiscal
19	year 2006 for supporting temporary assistance for needy family
20	programs on tribal land, to be distributed as follows:
21	(1) one million three hundred thirty-three
22	thousand dollars (\$1,333,000) for Navajo Nation programs
23	supporting temporary assistance for needy families; and
