17	Section 1. A new section of the Criminal Code is enacted

20	A. Gang recruitment consists of the solicitation or
21	recruitment of another with the intent that the person

23	(1) actively participate in a criminal street

(3) promote, further or assist in felonious conduct by members of a criminal street gang. 3

Whoever commits gang recruitment is guilty of a mi sdemeanor. Whoever commits gang recruitment of a minor is guilty of a fourth degree felony.

7 B. Gang recruitment by threat or violence consists 8 of threatening another with physical violence on two or more separate occasions within a thirty-day period, or using physical violence, with the intent to coerce, induce or solicit another to:

12 (1) actively participate in a criminal street 13 gang;

(2) participate in a pattern of criminal gang activity; or

promote, further or assist in felonious (3) conduct by members of a criminal street gang.

Whoever commits gang recruitment by threat or violence is guilty of a fourth degree felony. Whoever commits gang recruitment of a minor by threat or violence is guilty of a third degree felony.

As used in this section, "criminal street gang" C. means an ongoing organization, association or group of three or more persons, whether formal or informal, having a common name or identifying sign or symbol, whose members individually or . 153388. 2 - 2 -
