16	Section 1. A new section of the Public School Code is

20	A. The department shall by rule provide for
21	gathering and compiling information on Native American students
22	in public schools and reporting the data through the

A new section of the Public School Code is 13 enacted to read: 14 "[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] REPORT TO THE LEGISLATIVE INDIAN AFFAIRS 15 COMMITTEE REQUIRED. -- The secretary shall report annually to the 16 legislative Indian affairs committee at its October meeting or 17 its next meeting thereafter, summarizing the statistics 18 gathered pursuant to Section 1 of this act and discussing their 19 implications. In addition, the secretary shall issue an annual 20 report summarizing the statistics and distribute the report to 21 the Navajo Nation Indian education department and to all school 22 districts where Native Americans comprise thirty percent or 23 more of the student population." 24 - 3 -
