AN ACT
RELATI NG TO GENERAL WELFARE; LI M TI NG PERM SSI BLE USES OF SOCI AL SECURI TY I DENTI FI CATI ON NUMBERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEG SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO:
Section 1. SHORT TITLE.--This act may be cited as the "Soci al Security Number Confidentiality Act".

Section 2. DEFI NI TI ONS. - - As used in the Soci al Security Number Confidentiality Act:
A. "person" means a nat ur al person or a busi ness, association or governmental entity; and
B. "social security number" means the uni que ni nedi git number issued to a person by the federal social security admi ni stration.

Section 3. USE OF SOCI AL SECURI TY NUMBERS RESTRI CTED. - -
A. A person shall not make the entirety of a social
security number available to the general public. This prohi bition incl udes:
(1) intentionally commini cating a social security number to the general public;
(2) printing a social security number on a card requi red for the recei pt of products or services, i ncl uding cards i ssued for recei pt of services fromthe state or its political subdi vi sions;
(3) requi ring use of a social security number over the internet without a secure connection or encryption security;
(4) requi ring use of a social security number to access an internet account; and
(5) printing a social security number on materials mailed to a person unl ess required by law.
B. A person shal l not requi re use of the entirety of a social security number for an empl oyment application, credit application or ot her transaction, except for Iaw enf or cement, social security, medicare or medi caid purposes.
C. A person shall not refuse to transact busi ness because of a refusal to provi de the social security number, unl ess the social security number is required by federal or state law.
D. A person shall not transmit material that associates a social security number with an account number for . 153611. 1
a bank, savi ngs and loan associ ation or credit uni on, unl ess both numbers are requi red as part of an application or enrollment process or to establish, amend or terminate an account, contract or pol icy or to confirmthe accuracy of the soci al security, bank, savings and I oan associ ation or credit uni on account nunber.

Section 4. USE OF SOCI AL SECURI TY NUMBER PERM TTED. - -
A. A person may use a social security number if the social security number:
(1) is part of an application or enrollment process or to establish, arend or terminate an account, contract or policy;
(2) was furni shed for a document generated on or before December 31, 2005 and the person is copying or reproducing that document; or
(3) exists on an origi nal document generated on or bef ore Decenber 31, 2005.
B. A person may collect, use and rel ease a soci al security number as requi red by law or for internal verification or admini strative purposes.

Sect $i$ on 5. REPEAL. - Sect $i$ ons 57-12B- 1 through 57-12B- 3 NMSA 1978 (bei ng Laws 2003, Chapter 169, Sections 1 through 3) are repeal ed.

Section 6. EFFECTI VE DATE. - - The effective date of the provi si ons of this act is January 1, 2006.
