ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS, AMERICORPS PROGRAMS AND AMERICORPS AND

VOLUNTEERS IN SERVICE TO AMERICA PLACEMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. Seven hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$725,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the children, youth and families department for expenditure in fiscal year 2006 in the following amounts for the following purposes:

- (1) seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to support community volunteerism;
- (\$250,000) for matching educational scholarships to New Mexico . 153371.2

public post-secondary educational institutions for graduating
New Mexico high school students based upon the student's
community service and volunteerism in the local community;

- **(3)** two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to match local community funds leveraging federal funds for Americorps programs in New Mexico; and
- two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to support Americarps and volunteers in service to America placements in New Mexico communities.
- Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2006 shall revert to the general fund.
