16	Section 1. APPROPRIATIONSix hundred thousand dollars

19	expenditure in fiscal year 2006 to provide operational and
20	development funds to continue training for and expansion of use
21	of the statewide eMercado-NM vendor enhancement system that
22	coordinates purchasing conducted by large volume purchasers so
23	that their business remains in New Mexico with New Mexico
24	vendors. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at
25	the end of fiscal year 2006 shall revert to the general fund.
