school or a home school for the first forty days of school;
E. "home school" means the operation by the parent

of a school-age person of a home study program of instruction that provides a basic academic educational program, including reading, language arts, mathematics, social studies and science;

F. "instructional support provider" means a person who is employed to support the instructional program of a school district, including educational assistant, school counselor, social worker, school nurse, speech-language pathologist, psychologist, physical therapist, occupational therapist, recreational therapist, interpreter for the deaf and diagnostician;

G. "licensed school employee" means teachers, school administrators and instructional support providers;

H. "local school board" means the policy-setting body of a school district;

I. "local superintendent" means the chief executive officer of a school district;

J. "parent" includes a guardian or other person having custody and control of a school-age person; .153916.1

"public school" means that part of a school 6 district that is a single attendance center in which 7 instruction is offered by one or more teachers and is 8 discernible as a building or group of buildings generally 9 recognized as either an elementary, middle, junior high or high 10 school or any combination of those and includes a charter 11 school;

<u>M. "rural school district" means a school district</u> <u>located in a county whose population density is at or under</u> <u>thirty persons per square mile and whose largest city has a</u> <u>population under thirty thousand people</u>;

[M.] N. "school" means a supervised program of instruction designed to educate a student in a particular place, manner and subject area;

[N.] O. "school administrator" means a person licensed to administer in a school district and includes school principals and central district administrators;

 $[\Theta \cdot ]$  <u>P.</u> "school-age person" means a person who is at least five years of age prior to 12:01 a.m. on September 1 of the school year and who has not received a high school diploma or its equivalent. A maximum age of twenty-one shall .153916.1 - 3 -
