impairment of the function of a member or organ of the body.

C. A person convicted of failure to yield the right of way causing no great bodily injury or death shall be punished, in addition to other penalties imposed for the violation, by a fine of two hundred dollars (\$200) and a thirty-day suspension of the person's New Mexico driver's license, commercial driver's license or nonresident operating privilege.

D. A person convicted of failure to yield the right of way causing great bodily injury shall be punished, in addition to other penalties imposed for the violation, by a fine of five hundred dollars (\$500) and a ninety-day suspension of the person's New Mexico driver's license, commercial driver's license or nonresident operating privilege.

E. A person convicted of failure to yield the right of way causing death shall be punished, in addition to other penalties imposed for the violation, by a fine of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) and a six-month suspension of the person's New Mexico driver's license, commercial driver's license or nonresident operating privilege.
