AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE VETERANS' SERVICES DEPARTMENT FOR NAVAJO VETERANS OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--

A. One million nine hundred thirty-seven thousand seven hundred fourteen dollars (\$1,937,714) is appropriated from the general fund to the veterans' services department for expenditure in fiscal year 2006 in the following amounts and for the following purposes that serve Navajo veterans:

(\$86,500) to perform approximately one hundred twenty-five land surveys and to gain approximately one hundred seventy-one archaeological clearances for one-acre lots available for new home construction and rehabilitation projects on Navajo Nation .155829.1

one million seven hundred fifty thousand (2) dollars (\$1,750,000) for fifty housing units for Navajo veterans otherwise unable to finance a home at each of the fifty Navajo Nation chapters in New Mexico; and

one hundred one thousand two hundred (3) fourteen dollars (\$101,214) to establish a position for a statistician and demographer to develop a Navajo veterans database project documenting every Navajo veteran in New Mexico.

Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2006 shall revert to the general fund.
