AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE PROCUREMENT; AMENDING THE PROCUREMENT CODE TO REQUIRE THE APPROVAL OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL BEFORE A STATE AGENCY ENTERS INTO CERTAIN CONTRACTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new section of the Procurement Code is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] CONTRACTS--ATTORNEY GENERAL REVIEW.--

- Contracts entered into by a state agency that are not exempt from the provisions of the Procurement Code and that have a total cost in excess of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) shall be reviewed and approved by the office of the attorney general before final approval can be given by the contracting state agency.
- The provisions of this section do not apply to В. .156396.1

contracts for emergency procurements pursuant to the provisions of Section 13-1-127 NMSA 1978."
