16	Section 1. Section 27-5-7.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993,
17	Chapter 321, Section 16, as amended) is amended to read:
18	"27-5-7.1. COUNTY INDIGENT HOSPITAL CLAIMS FUND
19	AUTHORIZED USES OF THE FUND
20	A. The fund shall be used:
21	(1) to meet the county's contribution for
22	support of sole community provider payments as calculated by
23	the department for that county;
24	(2) to pay for expenses of burial or cremation
25	of an indigent person; [and]
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1	(3) to pay all claims that have been approved
2	by the board that are not matched with federal funds under the
3	state medicaid program; <u>and</u>
4	(4) to pay for emergency and specialty
5	inpatient and outpatient care delivered in a class A county by
6	a county hospital or other medical facility operated and
7	maintained by a state educational institution named in Article
8	12, Section 11 of the constitution of New Mexico and its
9	medical doctors, osteopathic physicians and other professional
10	providers when that care is not available within the county or
11	is necessary to address life-threatening injuries, illnesses or
12	disabilities of indigent residents of the county. Payment
13	shall not be less than amounts paid by the department for
14	medicaid patients who are not enrolled in managed care
15	organizations.
16	B. The fund may be used to meet the county's
17	obligation under Section 27-10-4 NMSA 1978."
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
