### AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIMINAL LAW; ENACTING A NEW SECTION OF THE CRIMINAL CODE TO PROHIBIT THE MISUSE OF ANHYDROUS AMMONIA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new section of the Criminal Code is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] ANHYDROUS AMMONIA--PROHIBITED CONDUCT-CRIMINAL PENALTIES.--

#### A. A person may not:

- (1) steal, purchase, possess, transfer or distribute any amount of anhydrous ammonia knowing or having reason to know that it will be used to unlawfully manufacture a controlled substance; or
- (2) place, have placed, transport or possess anhydrous ammonia in a container that is not designed,.156166.1
