AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY; PROHIBITING THE VIEWING OF TELEVISION OR OTHER VIDEO MONITORS BY DRIVERS OF MOTOR VEHICLES; ENACTING AND REPEALING SECTIONS OF THE NMSA 1978.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new section of the Motor Vehicle Code is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] FRONT SEAT TELEVISIONS AND VIDEO MONITORS
PROHIBITED.--

A. Except as provided in Subsection B of this section, it is unlawful to operate a motor vehicle in this state while text or images are projected on a video receiver, viewer, screen, monitor or source of television or video signal, broadcast or recorded entertainment or business application if those images are visible to the person operating .154987.1

- B. This section does not apply to the following equipment:
 - (1) a vehicle information display;
 - (2) a navigation or global positioning
 - (3) a mapping display;
- (4) a visual display used to monitor the area immediately to the rear or sides of a motor vehicle for the purpose of maneuvering the vehicle; or
- (5) a television or other video receiver, viewer, screen, monitor or source of television or video signal, broadcast or recorded entertainment or business application if that equipment has a device that, when the motor vehicle is being driven, disables the equipment for all uses except as a visual display as described in Paragraphs (1) through (4) of this subsection.
- C. This section does not apply to a recreational vehicle, to an authorized emergency vehicle or motor vehicle that provides emergency or roadside assistance or to a vehicle owned or operated by an electric, gas or telephone utility.
- E. This section does not prohibit the use of television-type receiving equipment used exclusively for safety or traffic engineering studies or in police, sheriff or .154987.1

emergency vehicles."

Section 2. REPEAL.--Section 66-7-358 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978, Chapter 35, Section 462, as amended by Laws 1989, Chapter 318, Section 31 and also by Laws 1989, Chapter 321, Section 1) is repealed.
