BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
Section 1. A new section of Article 13 of the Public
School Code is enacted to read:

A. School districts and charter schools may create
core curriculum frameworks to provide high quality curricula in
kindergarten through grade six to prepare students for pre-
advanced placement and advanced placement coursework in grades
seven through twelve.
B. The framework shall include:

1 a curriculum that is aligned with state (1) 2 academic content and performance standards that is challenging, 3 specific as to content and sequential from grade to grade, similar to a core curriculum sequence; 4 in-depth professional development for (2)5 6 teachers that includes vertical teaming in content areas; and 7 content, materials and instructional (3)8 strategies or methodologies that current research demonstrates 9 are likely to lead to improved student achievement in pre-10 advanced placement and advanced placement coursework in grades 11 seven through twelve. 12 **C**. The framework may be selected from previously 13 developed curricula or may be developed by the school district 14 or charter school. 15 A school district or charter school that meets D. 16 department eligibility requirements may apply to the department 17 for support of its core curriculum framework. Applications 18 shall be in the form prescribed by the department and shall 19 include the following information: 20 a statement of need; (1) 21 (2)goals and expected outcomes of the 22 framework; 23 (3) a detailed description of the curriculum 24 to be implemented; 25 (4) a detailed work plan and budget for the . 153009. 1 - 2 -

1 framework; 2 (5) documentation of the research upon which the anticipated success of the framework is based; 3 (6) a description of any partnership proposed 4 to implement the framework, supported by letters of commitment 5 from the partner; 6 7 (7) an evaluation plan; and 8 (8) any other information that the department 9 requi res. 10 Ε. The department shall award grants within ninety 11 days of the deadline for receipt of grant applications. 12 F. The department shall adopt and promulgate rules 13 to implement the provisions of this section." 14 Section 2. APPROPRIATION. -- Four hundred thousand dollars 15 (\$400,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the public 16 education department for expenditure in fiscal year 2006 to 17 provide grants to school districts that propose to implement 18 core curriculum frameworks. Any unexpended or unencumbered 19 balance remaining at the end of the fiscal year shall revert to 20 the general fund. 21 - 3 -22 23 24 25

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
