## Mr. Speaker:

Your EDUCATION COMMITTEE, to whom has been referred SENATE BILL 194, as amended

has had it under consideration and reports same with recommendation that it DO PASS, amended as follows:

- 1. Strike Senate Finance Committee Amendment 1.
- 2. On page 1, line 21, strike "ten" and insert in lieu thereof "eleven".
  - 3. On page 2, line 15, strike "and".
- 4. On page 2, line 19, strike the period and insert in lieu thereof a semicolon and between lines 19 and 20, insert the following new paragraphs:
- "(9) one member who possesses at least ten years of investment or public finance experience to be appointed by the New Mexico coalition of school administrators for a term of four years; and
- (10) one member to be appointed by the New Mexico federation of educational employees for a term of four years.".
- 5. On page 3, lines 1 through 6, strike Subsection D in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following new subsections:
- "D. A vacancy occurring in the term of an appointed member shall be filled by the appointing authority for the unexpired term. A vacancy occurring in the term of an elected member shall be filled by the appropriate association electing a new member to fill the unexpired term.
- E. During the first year of a new member's term, the member shall complete training on fiduciary responsibility, investing and financial expertise and such other matters as determined by the board."".
