18	A. [A fire] <u>An emergency</u> drill shall be conducted
19	in each public and private school of the state at least once
20	each week during the first four weeks of the school year and at
21	least once each month thereafter until the end of the school
22	year. <u>Two drills during the year shall be shelter-in-place</u>
23	drills and one shall be an evacuation drill, as directed by the
24	department. The remainder of the drills shall be fire drills.
25	It shall be the responsibility of the person in charge of a
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	1	school to carry out the provisions of this section.
	2	B. In locations where a [paid] fire department is
	3	maintained, a member of the fire department shall be requested
	4	to be in attendance during the [fire] emergency drills for the
	5	purpose of giving instruction and constructive criticism.
	6	C. The [state board] <u>department</u> shall determine
	7	penalties for any person failing to meet the provisions of this
