16	Section 1. CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES DEPARTMENT			
17	SOCIAL SECURITY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM			
18	A. The legislature finds that assisting youth in			
19	securing social security benefits is a cost-effective method to			
20	improve the lives of hundreds of children in state custody and			
21	improve their chances of returning to a safe and stable home.			
22	B. The children, youth and families department			
23	shall establish and maintain a social security assistance			
24	program to ensure that all children residing in state custody			
25	who are eligible for social security benefits apply for and

1 receive all benefits available to them. The department shall: 2 (1) screen all children in the custody of the department for eligibility for social security supplemental 3 4 security income and social security survivor's benefits. Each 5 child shall be screened within six months of entering the department's custody; provided that each child in the custody 6 7 of the department on July 1, 2005 shall be screened no later 8 than December 31, 2005; 9 (2)apply for supplemental security income and 10 survivor's benefits for each child determined by the screening 11 process to be, more likely than not, eligible for benefits 12 unless the department makes a determination, after an 13 individual inquiry, that seeking an application would not 14 benefit the child; and 15 (3) request reconsideration and timely appeal 16 of adverse decisions when appropriate. 17 The children, youth and families department С. 18 shall apply to be appointed representative payee on behalf of a 19 child beneficiary in its custody when no other appropriate 20 party is available to serve in that capacity. In its capacity 21 as representative payee, the department shall: 22 establish children's maintenance accounts. (1) 23 The department shall establish a no-cost, interest-bearing 24 account for each child in the department's custody for whom the 25 department serves as representative payee. 1 shall be credited to the account. The department shall keep an 2 itemized current account of all income and expense items for 3 each child's maintenance account; and establish procedures for disbursing money 4 (2)5 from the accounts, including disbursing the net balance to the beneficiary upon release from care. The department shall use 6 7 social security benefits only: 8 (a) for the use and benefit of the 9 child; 10 for purposes determined to be in the (b) 11 child's best interest: 12 (c) in accordance with a written 13 assessment of the child's individual needs; provided that each 14 child beneficiary shall receive a personal allowance of at 15 least thirty dollars (\$30.00) each month for the child's 16 personal use; and 17 (d) for the purpose of assisting a child 18 making the transition from the custody of the department to 19 self-sufficient living, by conserving the social security 20 benefits of the child beneficiary in lieu of reimbursing the 21 department for foster care maintenance beginning ninety days 22 prior to the eighteenth birthday of a child in the custody of 23 the department. 24 The children, youth and families advisory D. 25 committee shall, on a regular basis, evaluate the social . 153548. 1
