15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	Section 1. Section 21-16-14 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1963,
17	Chapter 108, Section 11, as amended) is amended to read:
18	"21-16-14. ADDITION OF SCHOOL DISTRICTS <u>OR PORTIONS OF</u>
19	SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO EXISTING TECHNICAL AND VOCATIONAL INSTITUTE

21	A. [Any] <u>A technical and vocational institute</u>
22	district may be expanded by either the procedure in Subsections
23	<u>B, C and D of this section or the procedure in Subsections E</u>
24	and F of this section.
25	<u>B. The qualified voters of a</u> school district,

1 portion of a school district, group of school districts within 2 a county containing a technical and vocational institute 3 district or [school districts] in an adjoining county, not included in the technical and vocational institute district as 4 5 originally formed, may petition the [state board of] public education department to be added to the technical and 6 7 vocational institute district. The [state board of education] 8 department shall examine the petition, and, if it finds that 9 the petition is signed by [the requisite number of qualified 10 voters as provided in Section 21-16-3 NMSA 1978] a number of 11 qualified voters residing within the pertinent school district 12 or portion of a school district equal to ten percent of the 13 votes cast for governor in such school district or portion of 14 such school district in the last preceding general election, 15 the [state board of education] department shall cause a survey 16 to be made of the petitioning district or districts to 17 determine the desirability of the proposed [extension of the 18 area] expansion of the technical and vocational institute 19 district.

[B.-] <u>C.</u> In conducting the survey, the [state board of education] department, in conjunction with the commission on higher education, shall ascertain the attitude of the technical and vocational institute board and collect other information [as prescribed in Section 21-16-3 NMSA 1978] it deems necessary. education] department finds that the proposed addition of the [school district or districts] petitioning area will promote an improved education service in the area, it shall approve the [Thereafter] The [state board of education] petition. secretary of public education shall proceed to call an election within the petitioning [school district or districts] area and 7 in the established technical and vocational institute district 8 on the question of the inclusion of the petitioning area in the institute district.

[C.] D. If [it appears on canvass of the results of the election that] a majority of the votes cast in [each of] the petitioning [school districts] area and a majority of the votes cast within the established institute district [was] are in favor of the addition of the [petitioning school district or districts] area, the [state board of education] department shall notify the local school board of each affected school district and the technical and vocational institute board of the results of the election and shall declare the extension of the boundaries of the institute district to include the petitioning [school district or districts] area in which the proposed addition referendum carried by a majority vote.

E. If a technical and vocational institute district includes less than all of a school district, the institute board, by resolution of a majority of the members of the board, may call an election within the institute district and in the . 154295. 1
