## AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A STATEWIDE INFORMATION AND REFERRAL TASK FORCE AND PILOT PROGRAM: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

## Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. Three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the developmental disabilities planning council for expenditure in fiscal years 2005 and 2006 to develop a statewide "211" information and referral system, as follows:

- (1) one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to establish an information and referral task force to develop a comprehensive implementation plan; and
- $\mbox{(2) two hundred thousand dollars ($200,000) to} \\ \mbox{develop and implement five "211" information and referral} \\ . 153947.1$

centers throughout the state.

\$B.\$ Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2006 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
