8. Change the succeeding subparagraph designations to paragraph designations accordingly.

9. On page 3, line 4, strike "or local ordinance".

10. On page 3, line 8, after the subsection designation "G." strike lines 8 through 12 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof:

"A county or municipality may at its option, and if it has the capability, permit access or use of its computer and network system
