signs using the words "No Smoking" or the international nosmoking symbol or both shall be posted either on all public entrances to the facility or school or in a position where the sign is clearly visible upon entry onto the facility's premises or the school campus.

A person who violates the provisions of Subsection A of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be sentenced in accordance with provisions of Section 31-19-1 NMSA 1978.

EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the Section 2. provisions of this act is July 1, 2005.
