## AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIMINAL LAW: CREATING A NEW CRIMINAL OFFENSE KNOWN AS CHILD ENDANGERMENT; PROVIDING PENALTIES; ENACTING A NEW SECTION OF THE NMSA 1978.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new section of Chapter 30, Article 6 NMSA 1978 is enacted to read:

## "[NEW MATERIAL] CHILD ENDANGERMENT. --

- Child endangerment consists of a person transporting a child in a motor vehicle while violating the provisions of Section 66-8-102 NMSA 1978, regarding driving while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs.
- Whoever commits child endangerment that does not result in injury to the child is guilty of a third degree fel ony.
