A. Two million dollars (\$2,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the commission on higher education for expenditure in fiscal year 2006 in the following amounts for the following purposes:

(1) one million four hundred eighty-five thousand six hundred dollars (\$1,485,600) to expand funding for faculty salaries, faculty positions and classroom capacity and to develop programs to increase student retention in nursing programs at institutions of higher learning statewide with special emphasis on support for community, branch and junior colleges serving rural areas of New Mexico; and
