14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	Section 1. A new section of the New Mexico
16	Telecommunications Act is enacted to read:
17	"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] TERMINATION OF RURAL EXTENSION FUNDS
18	A. After June 30, 2005, the commission shall not
19	require a telecommunications company to establish or continue
20	to accrue money to a rural extension fund. The obligation of a
21	single telecommunications company to accrue additional money to
22	an existing rural extension fund shall terminate on July 1,
23	2005.
24	B. A telecommunications company with an accrued,
25	unspent balance in a rural extension fund as of July 1, 2005

shall apply the balance to extend local exchange telecommunications service to qualifying rural customers. If an unspent balance remains after all qualifying rural customers are served, the telecommunications company shall apply the unspent balance to the installation of telecommunications infrastructure for digital subscriber lines or broadband or other advanced services such as telemedicine networks or distance learning networks in that telecommunications company's certificated service area. A residential or commercial real estate developer shall not benefit directly from telecommunications projects funded pursuant to this section.

C. As used in this section, "rural extension fund" means a fund reserved, set aside or in any other manner accrued by a telecommunications company pursuant to an order, rule, tariff or other requirement of the commission for the purpose of supporting or subsidizing the extension of lines or facilities by the telecommunications company to serve customers in rural or other low-density service areas."
