Section 34-6-5 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1968, Section 1. Chapter 69, Section 8, as amended) is amended to read:

"34-6-5. JUDGES--SECOND JUDICIAL DISTRICT. -- There shall be twenty-three district judges in the second judicial di stri ct. Additionally, the district may hire retired judges for temporary service to hear cases of alleged probation vi ol ati on. "

Section 2. APPROPRIATION. -- Seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the second judicial district for expenditure in fiscal year 2006 to pay for temporary judges hired to hear cases of alleged probation . 154454. 2
