BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 11-13A-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1999, Chapter 252, Section 1) is amended to read:

"11-13A-1. SHORT TITLE.--[This act] Chapter 11, Article

13A NMSA 1978 may be cited as the "Compact Negotiation Act"."

Section 2. A new section of the Compact Negotiation Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] GAMING ON LANDS ACQUIRED IN TRUST AFTER OCTOBER 17, 1988--LEGISLATIVE AUTHORIZATION REQUIRED.--The governor may not concur in a determination by the federal government that class III gaming may be conducted on lands in .156020.1
