14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	Section 1. APPROPRIATIONOne hundred sixty-seven
16	thousand dollars (\$167,000) is appropriated from the general
17	fund to the aging and long-term services department for
18	expenditure in fiscal year 2006 for a federal demonstration
19	project known as "naturally occurring retirement communities"
20	and to contract with a collaboration of community service
21	providers to provide a coordinated array of services to elderly
22	persons seeking to remain in their own homes through this
23	demonstration project. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance
24	remaining at the end of fiscal year 2006 shall revert to the
25	general fund.
