15	Section 1. Section 8-8-4 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1998,
16	Chapter 108, Section 4) is amended to read:
17	"8-8-4. COMMISSIONGENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES
18	A. The commission shall administer and enforce the
19	laws with which it is charged and has every power conferred by
20	l aw.
21	B. The commission may:
22	(1) subject to legislative appropriation,
23	appoint and employ such professional, technical and clerical
24	assistance as it deems necessary to assist it in performing its
25	powers and duties;

1 (2) delegate authority to subordinates as it deems necessary and appropriate, clearly delineating such 2 delegated authority and any limitations; 3 retain competent attorneys, including a 4 (3) general counsel who shall be hired solely on the person's 5 qualifications and fitness to perform the duties of the 6 7 position and who shall be removed only for cause, to handle the 8 legal matters of the commission and give advice and counsel in 9 regard to any matter connected with the duties of the 10 commission and, in the discretion of the commission, to 11 represent the commission in any legal proceeding; 12 organize into organizational units as (4) 13 necessary to enable it to function most efficiently, subject to 14 provisions of law requiring or establishing specific 15 organizational units; 16 take administrative action by issuing (5) 17 orders not inconsistent with law to assure implementation of 18 and compliance with the provisions of law for which the 19 commission is responsible and to enforce those orders by 20 appropriate administrative action and court proceedings; 21 (6) conduct research and studies to improve 22 the commission's operations or the provision of services to the 23 citizens of New Mexico: 24 (7) conduct investigations as necessary to 25 carry out the commission's responsibilities;

(c) limiting repetitious testimony; and 3 (d) adopting procedures for resolving cases in ways other than by trial-type hearings when appropriate, including consent calendars, conferences, settlements, mediation, arbitration and other alternative dispute resolution methods and the use of staff decisions; and provide a toll-free telephone number and (4) publish it and the commission's general telephone number in local telephone directories. D. A majority of the commission constitutes a quorum for the transaction of business; provided, however, that a majority vote of the commission is needed for a final decision of the commission." Section 8-8-5 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1998, Section 2. Chapter 108, Section 5, as amended) is amended to read: "8-8-5. CHIEF OF STAFF--DIVISION DIRECTORS--OTHER STAFF. - -The commission shall appoint a "chief of staff" A. who is responsible for the day-to-day operations of the commission staff under the general direction of the commission. The chief of staff shall [serve at the pleasure of the <del>commission</del>] have significant administrative, budgetary and regulatory experience and expertise and shall be appointed solely based on qualifications to perform the duties of the . 155805. 1 4 -

position and without reference to political party affiliation.

B. The chief of staff may be removed only for cause by the commission.

4 [B.-] C. With the consent of the commission, the
5 chief of staff shall appoint division directors. The chief of
6 staff may remove a division director only for cause.
7 Appointments shall be made without reference to party
8 affiliation and solely on [the ground of fitness to perform the duties
9 duties of their offices] qualifications to perform the duties
10 of the position.

[ $\bigcirc$  ]  $\underline{D}$ . Each director, with the consent of the chief of staff, shall employ such professional, technical and support staff as necessary to carry out the duties of his division. Employees shall be hired solely on the ground of their fitness to perform the job for which they are hired. Except as provided in Subsection [ $\oiint$ ]  $\underline{E}$  of this section, division staff are subject to the provisions of the Personnel Act.

[<del>D.</del>] <u>E.</u> With the consent of the chief of staff, the superintendent of insurance may designate the following insurance division positions as exempt from the provisions of the Personnel Act: deputy superintendents, chief actuaries and bureau chiefs."
