16	Section 1. A new section of Chapter 1, Article 9 NMSA

20	the Election Code shall produce a voter-verifiable paper ballot

voter-verifiable paper ballot to record the voters' preferences
may be used until the first occurrence of the following:

A. adequate federal, state or local funds are appropriated to replace those voting systems; or

B. July 1, 2008."

Section 2. A new section of Chapter 1, Article 9 NMSA 1978 is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] VOTING SYSTEMS--TESTING OF PREVIOUSLY CERTIFIED SYSTEMS.--The secretary of state may voluntarily test and certify voting systems without an application by the manufacturer if the system has been previously certified by other states or by the national association of state election directors. Tests and inspections conducted pursuant to this section shall follow the testing procedures in Section 1-9-14 NMSA 1978 and shall be completed within six months of the date on which testing begins; provided, however, that if the manufacturer has not applied for certification of that voting system, the manufacturer shall not be required to pay for the costs of testing and certification."

Section 3. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
