7 Section 2. TEMPORARY PROVISION -- COURT CLOSURES -- CLERK POSITIONS--OTHER RESOURCES.--The magistrate court clerk 8 9 positions assigned to the magistrate courts shall not be 10 decreased as a result of this act, but the administrative 11 office of the courts shall reassign positions from the 12 abolished court to other magistrate courts. The administrative 13 office of the courts shall reassign other resources, including 14 furniture, equipment and supplies, to other magistrate courts 15 as needed.
