AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGHER EDUCATION; REQUIRING AN ELECTION IN A SCHOOL DISTRICT PARTIALLY WITHIN A TECHNICAL AND VOCATIONAL INSTITUTE DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR READJUSTMENT OF DISTRICT BOUNDARIES; CLARIFYING ELECTION PROCEDURES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 21-16-14 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1963, Chapter 108, Section 11, as amended) is amended to read:

"21-16-14. ADDITION OF SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO EXISTING TECHNICAL AND VOCATIONAL INSTITUTE DISTRICTS-- WITHDRAWAL OF SCHOOL DISTRICTS. --

A. Any school district, group of school districts within a county or school districts in an adjoining county not included in the technical and vocational institute district as originally formed, may petition the ~~[state board of]~~ public

1 education department to be added to the technical and
2 vocational institute district. The [~~state board of education~~]
3 department shall examine the petition, and, if it finds that
4 the petition is signed by [~~the requisite number of qualified~~
5 ~~voters as provided in Section 21-16-3 NMSA 1978, the state~~
6 ~~board of education~~] a number of voters residing within each
7 school district equal to ten percent or more of the votes cast
8 for governor in each school district in the last general
9 election, the department shall cause a survey to be made of
10 [~~the~~] each petitioning district [~~or districts~~] to determine the
11 desirability of the proposed extension of the area of the
12 technical and vocational institute district.

13 B. In conducting the survey, the [~~state board of~~]
14 public education department, in conjunction with the commission
15 on higher education, shall ascertain the attitude of the
16 technical and vocational institute board and collect other
17 information [~~as prescribed in Section 21-16-3 NMSA 1978~~] it
18 deems appropriate. If on the basis of the survey the [~~state~~
19 ~~board of education~~] department finds that the proposed addition
20 of the school district or districts will promote an improved
21 education service in the area, it shall approve the petition.
22 Thereafter, the [~~state board of education~~] department shall
23 proceed to call an election within [~~the~~] each petitioning
24 school district [~~or districts~~] and in the established technical
25 and vocational institute district on the question of the

1 inclusion of the area in the institute district. The election
2 shall be called, conducted and canvassed as provided in the
3 School Election Law except that the secretary of public
4 education shall serve in place of the superintendent.

5 C. If ~~[it appears on canvass of the results of the~~
6 ~~election that]~~ a majority of the votes cast in each of the
7 petitioning school districts and within the established
8 institute district was in favor of the addition of the
9 petitioning school district or districts, the ~~[state board of]~~
10 public education department shall notify the local school board
11 of each school district and the technical and vocational
12 institute board of the results of the election and shall
13 declare the extension of the boundaries of the institute
14 district to include the petitioning school district or
15 districts in which the proposed addition referendum carried by
16 a majority vote.

17 D. Each school district added to any existing
18 technical and vocational institute district shall automatically
19 be subject to any special levy on taxable property approved for
20 the institute district for the maintenance of facilities and
21 services and for support of bond issues.

22 E. In any school district, the entire area of which
23 is not wholly within a technical and vocational institute
24 district, and which has not held an election by the voters
25 residing within the entire school district on the question of

1 whether the school district should be a part of the technical
2 and vocational institute district, an election shall be held to
3 vote on the question. The election shall be conducted as part
4 of the next regularly scheduled election for the board of
5 education of the school district by placing on the ballot the
6 question of whether the area of the entire school district
7 should be included in the technical and vocational institute
8 district.

9 F. If a majority of the votes cast in the school
10 district is in favor of the inclusion of the area of the entire
11 school district in the technical and vocational institute
12 district, the public education department shall notify the
13 technical and vocational institute board of the results of the
14 election and shall declare the extension of the boundaries of
15 the technical and vocational institute district to include the
16 area of the entire school district on the next succeeding
17 July 1. Property in a school district added pursuant to this
18 subsection shall automatically be subject to any special levy
19 on taxable property as any other property within the technical
20 and vocational institute district.

21 G. If a majority of the votes cast in the school
22 district is against the inclusion of the area of the entire
23 school district in the technical and vocational institute
24 district, the public education department shall notify the
25 technical and vocational institute board of the results of the

1 election and shall declare the withdrawal of the school
2 district from the boundaries of the technical and vocational
3 institute district effective on the next succeeding July 1.

4 H. The territory of a school district withdrawn
5 from a technical and vocational institute district as provided
6 in Subsection G of this section shall continue to be subject to
7 any special levy on taxable property for the technical and
8 vocational institute district, for the maintenance of
9 facilities and services and for support of bond issues,
10 approved during the time that territory was a part of the
11 technical and vocational institute district and before the
12 election provided for in Subsection E of this section."
