#### CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN TAOS COUNTY

This capital outlay request is revised to read as follows:

• to the department of environment

#### TAOS CO REGIONAL WATER/WWATER FEASIBILITY STUDY

fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for a feasibility study to assess water and wastewater regional system needs in the Penasco and Embudo watersheds in Taos county

• to the interstate stream commission

#### TAOS CO WATER MEASUREMENT STRUCTURES CONSTRUCT

twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to plan, design and construct water measurement structures in the Rio Hondo communities for the Taos Valley acequia association in Taos county

• to the local government division of the department of finance and administration

#### POT CREEK WILDCARD URBAN INTERFACE FUEL REDUCTION

twenty-one thousand dollars (\$21,000) to purchase equipment for the Pot Creek wildcard urban interface fuel reduction program in Taos county

#### POT CREEK/RANCHOS DE TAOS FIRE STATION CONSTRUCT

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design and construct a fire station for Pot Creek and Ranchos de Taos in Taos county

fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to furnish and equip the Rio Grande alcohol treatment facility in Embudo in Rio Arriba county
