8	A. The "funding formula study task force" is	
9	created. The task force shall function from the date of its	
10	appointment until December 15, 2006.	
11	B. The task force is composed of the following	
12	members:	
13	(1) three members from the house of	
14	representatives and three members from the senate appointed	
15	by the New Mexico legislative council;	
16	(2) three members appointed by the governor;	
17	(3) four representatives of public school	
18	administrators, including one each from a small district, a	
19	growth district, an impact aid district and a mid-sized	
20	district. The members shall be appointed by the New Mexico	
21	legislative council from a list submitted by the New Mexico	
22	superintendents' association; and	
23	(4) the president of the New Mexico school	
24	board association or the president's designee.	
25	C. Vacancies on the task force shall be filled by	SB 125 Page 1

appointment by the original appointing authority.

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D. Members of the task force are entitled to per diem and mileage as provided in the Per Diem and Mileage Act and shall receive no other compensation, perquisite or allowance.

E. Staff for the task force shall be provided by
the legislative council service, the legislative education
study committee, the legislative finance committee, the
public education department and the office of education
accountability of the department of finance and
administration. Staff shall provide technical assistance to
the contractor.

F. The task force shall:

14 (1) develop a work plan and budget for15 approval by the New Mexico legislative council;

16 (2) approve the request for proposals for a 17 contractor to conduct the study of the public school funding 18 formula and select the contractor; and

19 (3) make recommendations to the legislature20 and the governor by December 15, 2006.

G. The request for proposals shall request a
comprehensive study of the public school funding formula,
including the expectations of the public and statutory
requirements for New Mexico's public education system; the
costs of those expectations and requirements; and a thorough SB 125

1	analysis of all formula components and consideration of	
2	possible changes to the formula, including:	
3	(1) a revised training and experience index	
4	aligned to the three-tiered licensure system for teachers;	
5	(2) size factors associated with small

8	affect the equity and efficacy of the funding formula as a
