2 C. The framework may be selected from previously 3 developed curricula or may be developed by the school district or charter school. 4 5 D. A school district or charter school that meets 6 department eligibility requirements may apply to the department for support of its core curriculum framework. 7 8 Applications shall be in the form prescribed by the 9 department and shall include the following information: 10 (1) a statement of need; (2) goals and expected outcomes of the 11 framework; 12 a detailed description of the curriculum 13 (3) to be implemented; 14 15 (4) a detailed work plan and budget for the framework; 16 (5) documentation of the research upon which 17 the anticipated success of the framework is based; 18 (6) a description of any partnership 19 20 proposed to implement the framework, supported by letters of commitment from the partner; 21 (7) an evaluation plan; and 22 (8) any other information that the 23 department requires. 24 The department shall award grants within ninety SB 138 25 Ε.
