1	AN ACT
2	RELATING TO HIGHER EDUCATION; CREATING THE TECHNOLOGY
3	RESEARCH COLLABORATIVE.
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5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
6	Section 1. TECHNOLOGY RESEARCH COLLABORATIVE CREATED
7	PURPOSE
8	A. The "technology research collaborative" is
9	created. The New Mexico institute of mining and technology
10	shall be the fiscal agent for the collaborative.
11	B. Participating institutions associated with the
12	collaborative shall include national laboratories, other
13	major research institutes and all the post-secondary
14	institutions of New Mexico.
15	C. The purposes of the collaborative are to:
16	(1) establish advanced technology centers
17	based on the wealth of scientific and technical talent that
18	exists in the member institutions;
19	(2) develop and create new intellectual
20	property for the state and encourage new opportunities for
21	business and increased jobs;
22	(3) commercialize the intellectual property;
23	and
24	(4) create a work force to support
25	enterprises based on the intellectual property.

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1	D. Intellectual property created by an employee or
2	agent of an institution associated with the collaborative
3	shall be owned by that institution. Intellectual property
4	created jointly shall be owned jointly. If the intellectual
5	property is created using federal funds, the applicable
6	federal laws and regulations shall govern the ownership.
7	E. The collaborative may receive appropriations
8	from the legislature through the board of regents of the New
9	Mexico institute of mining and technology and may receive any
10	other items of value from public or private sources.
11	F. The "board of the technology research
12	collaborative" is created. The board shall consist of eleven
13	members as follows:
14	(1) the governor, or the governor's
15	designee, who shall chair the collaborative;
16	(2) the presidents, or their designees, of
17	the university of New Mexico, New Mexico state university and
18	New Mexico institute of mining and technology;
19	(3) five members at large, appointed by the
20	governor with the consent of the senate;
21	(4) the director of Sandia national
22	laboratories, or the director's designee; and
23	(5) the director of Los Alamos national
24	laboratory, or the director's designee.

G. Appointed members shall serve for two-year

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1	terms at the pleasure of the governor. Members serve until
2	their successors have been appointed. The governor may fill
3	any vacancy on the board for the remainder of an unexpired
4	term.
5	H. The board may elect officers as it deems
6	necessary to carry out its duties. A majority of the members
7	of the board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of
8	business, and shall meet four times per year. Board members
9	shall not vote by proxy.
10	I. Public members of the board shall receive per
11	diem and mileage pursuant to the Per Diem and Mileage Act and
12	shall receive no other compensation, perquisite or allowance.
13	J. The board shall:
14	(1) employ a director and other staff, who
15	shall be exempt from the provisions of the Personnel Act, as
16	the board deems necessary to provide continuity and management
17	of the collaborative; and
18	(2) prepare annual reports to the
19	legislature on expenditures and progress of the collaborative.
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
