C. For the purpose of tuition payment at resident student rates at New Mexico highlands university, "resident student" may include any person who is a Native American and a citizen of the United States.

D. For the purposes of tuition payment and budget and revenue calculations, the board of regents of any post-secondary, state educational institution enumerated in Article 12, Section 11 of the constitution of New Mexico may determine that "resident student" includes any Texas resident who resides within a one hundred thirty-five mile radius of that institution.

E. For the purpose of tuition payment and budget
and revenue calculations, "resident student" includes any
student receiving an athletic scholarship from a
post-secondary educational institution set forth in
Article 12, Section 11 of the constitution of New Mexico.

18 F. For the purpose of tuition payment and budget 19 and revenue calculations, "resident student" includes a member 20 of an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo located wholly or 21 partially in New Mexico, regardless of the residence of the 22 member prior to acceptance at a post-secondary educational 23 institution enumerated in Article 12, Section 11 of the 24 constitution of New Mexico for either undergraduate or 25 post-graduate enrollment."
