Section 16-4-10 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1983, 8 Chapter 18, Section 2) is amended to read: 9 "16-4-10. DECLARATION OF POLICY AND FUNDING INTENT.--10 Α. The preservation, protection and maintenance of 11 the natural and scenic beauty of a designated portion of the 12 Rio Grande and its immediate corridor is in the public 13 interest. The designation of the Rio Grande Valley state 14 park will enable people to enjoy the recreational, 15 environmental, educational and wildlife benefits of the 16 river. Therefore, the legislature declares it to be in the 17 public interest, in furtherance of sound environmental policy 18 and for the good of the people to establish the Rio Grande 19 Valley state park. 20 It is the intent of the Rio Grande Valley State Β. 21 Park Act that the state parks division of the energy, 22 minerals and natural resources department not bear the 23 operating costs for the Rio Grande Valley state park except 24 for the area within the Rio Grande nature center state park.

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The state may expend funds within the boundaries of the

1	entire Rio Grande Valley state park as it deems appropriate."
