11	court, the administrative office of the courts shall create a
12	"consolidation study committee" to study the potential
13	consolidation of the magistrate and municipal courts in Dona
14	Ana county. The committee shall consist of fifteen members
15	as follows:
16	(l) a district judge from the third judicial
17	district, appointed by the chief judge of the district;
18	(2) a Dona Ana county magistrate judge,
19	appointed by the director of the administrative office of the
20	courts;
21	(3) a municipal judge from the city of Las
22	Cruces, appointed by the director of the administrative
23	office of the courts;
24	(4) three attorneys who commonly practice in
25	the Dona Ana county magistrate court or the city of

1	Las Cruces municipal court, appointed by the third judicial
2	district bar association;
3	(5) one public member appointed by the mayor
4	of the city of Las Cruces;
5	(6) one public member appointed by the board
6	of county commissioners for Dona Ana county;

8	Dona Ana county magistrate court, appointed by the
9	magistrates;
10	(8) one administrative employee from the
11	city of Las Cruces municipal court, appointed by the
12	municipal judges;
13	(9) one administrative employee from the
14	third judicial district court, appointed by the district
15	court judges;
16	(10) a designee of the director of the
17	administrative office of the courts;
18	(11) the district attorney for the third
19	judicial district;
20	(12) the district public defender for the
21	third judicial district; and
22	(13) a member of the city council of the
23	city of Las Cruces, appointed by the city council.
24	B. The committee shall elect a chair and such
25	other officers as it deems necessary. The committee shall

meet at the call of the chair but no less than once per The committee may contract with a part-time individual to assist the committee with its administrative functions. C. The committee shall investigate and evaluate the effectiveness and judicial efficiency of community-based judicial systems in other areas and determine the feasibility of creating a consolidated system in the Dona Ana county court The committee shall report its findings and

recommendation to the city council, the board of county commissioners and the legislature by December 1, 2005._____
