1 A JOINT MEMORIAL 2 REQUESTING THE NEW MEXICO LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL TO NAME A 3 LOTTERY SCHOLARSHIP STUDY COMMITTEE. 4 5 WHEREAS, the lottery tuition scholarship program has 6 been a major success in New Mexico, allowing over thirty-two 7 thousand young residents of the state to achieve their dream 8 of higher education and allowing more New Mexico high school 9 graduates to stay in the state for higher education and then 10 employment; and 11 WHEREAS, the program serves New Mexico's publicly funded 12 colleges and universities by increasing enrollment and 13 revenue attributed to tuition; and 14 WHEREAS, the program also reduces the burden of the 15 state's taxpayers to fund overall public higher education by 16 providing another revenue stream for public colleges and 17 universities; and 18 WHEREAS, the program currently provides tuition 19 assistance to recent high school graduates and veterans who 20 enlisted in the armed services after graduation and are now 21 returning to New Mexico; and 22 WHEREAS, the scholarship program is based on students' 23 academic merit, requiring that students maintain a 2.5 grade 24 point average with a course load of at least twelve credit

hours; and

SJM 74 Page 1 WHEREAS, at least twelve bills have been introduced this year for the legislature to change the lottery tuition scholarship program, some of which expand the purpose of the scholarship from tuition to other expenses, some of which propose changing the program from a merit program to a needs-based program and some of which propose opening the program to more people and types of institutions; and

WHEREAS, arguably, that many proposals on a single topic may mean that there is not yet a consensus in the legislature on how the program should be designed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico legislative council be requested to appoint an interim legislative committee to study the lottery tuition scholarship program and make recommendations to the legislative council by December 15, 2005; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the co-chairs of the New Mexico legislative council.________SJN Pag
