A JOINT RESOLUTION
PROPOSING THAT OWNERSHIP OF PROPERTY USED FOR AIRPORT RUNWAYS
AT CONCHAS LAKE STATE PARK IN SAN MIGUEL COUNTY AND NAVAJO
LAKE STATE PARK IN SAN JUAN COUNTY BE RETURNED TO THE
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.
WHEREAS, Section 13-6-3 NMSA 1978 requires ratification
and approval of any sale, trade or lease of state property

for a period exceeding twenty-five years and of over one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) in value; and

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WHEREAS, in April 1979, the department of transportation deeded land at Conchas Lake state park in San Miguel county to the property control division of the general services department for use as an airport runway; and

WHEREAS, the property in San Miguel county is described as:

17 "A certain tract of land situated in the Pablo 18 Montoya Grant, San Miguel County, New Mexico, more 19 particularly described as follows: 20 Beginning at the Northwest corner of 21 said tract, which is a point on the 22 southerly right-of-way line of State 23 Road 104 at station 1279/59.38, whence 24 the United States Corps of Engineers 25 SJR 6 Boundary Marker No. 2 bears N 36° 27' E,

2	feet to a point, thence S 77 $^{\circ}$ 26' E,
3	4900.30 feet to the Northeast corner,

12	62.132 acres more or less.
13	Together with the following described avigation
14	[sic] easement, to-wit:
15	Beginning at the Northwest corner of
16	said tract which is a point on the
17	easterly boundary of the Department
18	of Aviation, State of New Mexico,
19	fee simple title property, described
20	above, whence the Northeast corner
21	of the Department of Aviation, State
22	of New Mexico, fee simple title
23	property, described above, bears N
24	12° 34' E, 50.00 feet, thence S 77°
25	26' E, 900.00 feet to the Northeast

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corner, thence S 12° 34' W, 300.00 1 2 feet to the southeast corner, thence 3 N 77° 26' W, 900.00 to the southwest 4 corner, a point on the East boundary 5 of the Department of Aviation, State of New Mexico, fee simple title 6 7 property, described above, thence N 8 $12^{\circ} 34'$ E, 300.00 feet to the point 9 of beginning and containing 6.198 10 acres more or less, located within the Pablo Montoya Grant, San Miguel 11 12 County, New Mexico."; and 13 WHEREAS, in January 1982, the department of 14 transportation deeded land at Navajo Lake state park in San 15 Juan county to the property control division of the general 16 services department for use as an airport runway; and 17 WHEREAS, the property in San Juan county is described 18 as: 19 "The United States of American [sic] executed a 20 patent to the Department of Aviation, State of New 21 Mexico, for airport purposes, dated June 26, 1969, 22 covering a portion of the surface rights of lands 23 more particularly described as follows, to-wit: 24 "Lots five, six, seven, nine, ten, 25 eleven, twelve, thirteen, and fourteen

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1 of section 14; and lots one, two, three, 2 four, and the south half of the south-3 west quarter of section 15, in township 4 thirty North of range eight West of the 5 New Mexico Principal meridian, New 6 Mexico, containing a total of 560.08 7 acres, according to the approved plats 8 of survey thereof on file in the Bureau 9 of Land Management, Department of the 10 Interior."; and 11 WHEREAS, the properties are operated by the state parks 12 division of the energy, minerals and natural resources 13 department; and 14 WHEREAS, the state parks division and the property 15 control division are not able to properly maintain the 16 runways; and 17 WHEREAS, the department of transportation is able to 18 maintain these runways if the property is under jurisdiction 19 of the department of transportation; and 20 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the state to have 21 properly maintained runways at these state parks; 22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE 23 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the transfer from the property 24 control division of the general services department to the 25 aviation division of the department of transportation of
