Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 25 amends the Election Code to include a provision requiring the Secretary of State to promulgate rules to ensure the uniform counting of provisional ballots.

Significant Issues

House Bill 25 does not include recommendations for rules ensuring uniform counting of provisional ballots.
