### Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 334 appropriates \$2 million from the general fund to CYFD to support, expand, and improve domestic violence centers statewide.

## Significant Issues

The bill does not specify the types of expenditures or activities allowable under the appropriation.

### PERFORMANCE IMPLICATIONS

Increased program and service capacity statewide would allow CYFD to serve a greater number of domestic violence victims and offenders.

# FISCAL IMPLICATIONS
