SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 401 allows for the issuance of citations for certain traffic violations based on evidence gathered from automated traffic enforcement systems. The proposed legislation would authorize the use of cameras in recording and issuing citations for misdemeanor offenses. The proposed legislation also allows police departments to create forms to use in issuing these citations.

PERFORMANCE IMPLICATIONS

AODA states few District Attorneys' offices are involved in the prosecution of traffic citations. Many offices assist law enforcement agencies on a case by case basis. The AODA anticipates that there will be more requests for assistance.

AODA states they anticipate that many cases will be contested on the issue of identity of the driver.
