# SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of SEC Amendment

Senate Education Committee amendment to HB604 amends the legislation as follows:

• On page 2, line 19: after he word "campuses" insert the language ", provided no name is adopted in honor of a living person".

Senate Education Committee amendment to HB604 attaches no appropriation to the legislation.

#### Synopsis of HEC Amendment

House Education Committee amendment to HB604 amends the legislation as follows:

#### House Bill 604/aHEC/aSEC -- Page 2

- On page 1, line 18: Before "The" inserts the subsection designation "A.".
- On page 1, line 19: deletes "A." and inserts "(1)" in lieu thereof.
- On page 2, line 1: deletes "B." and inserts "(2)" in lieu thereof.
- On page 2, line 2: deletes "C." and inserts "(3)" in lieu thereof.
- On page 2, line 4: deletes "D." and inserts "(4)" in lieu thereof.
- On page 2, line 9: deletes "E." and inserts "(5)" in lieu thereof.
- On page 2, line 13: deletes "F." inserts "(6)" in lieu thereof.
- On page 2, line 17: deletes "G." and inserts "(7)" in lieu thereof.
- On page 2, line 19: deletes the closing quotation marks.
- On page 2, between lines 19 and 20: inserts a new Subsection B to read:

"B. Whenever the board changes the name of a technical vocational institute or the institute's campuses:

(1) functions, personnel, appropriations, money, records, equipment and other property of the formerly named institute or campuses shall be transferred to the newly named institute or campuses;

(2) existing contracts and agreements in effect as to the formerly named institute or campuses shall be binding on the newly named institute or campuses; and

(3) references in state or local law to the formerly named institute or campuses shall be deemed to refer to the newly named institute or campuses."

House Education Committee amendment to HB604 attaches no appropriation to the legislation.

#### Original Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 604 – Relating to Higher Education; Authorizing a Technical and Vocational Institute District Board to Adopt or Change the Name of the Institute – amends Section 21-16-6 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1963, Chapter 108, Section 6, as amended) as follows:

# Under 21-16-6: Board – Powers and Duties:

D: Amends the language so that the Commission on Higher Education – as opposed to the Board of Educational Finance – has authority to approve associate degree programs.

# House Bill 604/aHEC/aSEC -- Page 3

G: Adds language to authorize the Board to adopt a name for, or change the name of the technical and vocational institute or the institute's campuses.

There is no appropriation attached to this legislation.
